The horror genre exists to scare readers by employing every weapon in its arsenal, from subtle supernatural chills to visceral blood, guts, and gore.

Try one of the following authors for a taste of horror: Stephen King, Joe Hill or Laurell K. Hamilton. Classic Horror authors include Edgar Allen Poe and H.P. Lovecraft. For some lighter horror reading, Charlene Harris is one to try.
