Biography

Housed in the library's "Biography" section are books which are either biography, autobiography or memoir.

Autobiographies are books about a person's life, written by that same person.

Biographies are narratives about someone's life written by a different author.

A memoir is similar to an autobiography. The subject is usually more of a narrative about the author's experience or relationship with a certain person, experience or time.

Biographies, autobiographies and memoirs are considered part of a library's nonfiction collection.
