LEAF COLLECTION: Leaf collection will commence on April 17th in the Borough and will continue until all leaves have been collected. You may place the leaves in loose piles at the curb, or you may place them in clear bags at the curblineline. Residents may also bring their bagged leaves to the Public Works Yard located at 161 Center Street for disposal.

EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM: Freehold Borough has implemented an Emergency Notification System which allows us to alert residents in times of severe weather, road closings, hydrant flushing, and other emergencies as they arise. All residents and businesses are encouraged to register for the program by going online to our website, www.freeholdboro.org to register at "Everbridge Emergency Alerts" at the top of our homepage.

BOROUGH WIDE CLEANUP DAY: The fourth annual Mayor's Cleanup Day will be held on Saturday, May 16th from 8:00 am - 2:00 p.m. During the week of May 11th, residents will be permitted to discard up to five bulk items on each of their two trash collection days that week. Additionally, containers will be placed at the DPW site at 161 Center Street and the Park Avenue School between 8:00 am - 2:00 pm. We will also be providing paper shredding services at Borough Hall from 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. for residents to safely dispose of their important papers and documents.

The Freehold Borough Education Foundation will be collecting outgrown and used bicycles to be given to local children as part of Cleanup Day. Bring your bike(s) on May 16th to the Freehold Learning Center or Park Avenue School between the hours of 8:00 a.m.- noon.

TREE PLANTING PROGRAM: Freehold Borough will be planting shade trees this Spring to replace those which were damaged or destroyed by Superstorm Sandy and Hurricane Irene. Any resident who would like to have trees planted on their property should contact Daniel Megill at 732 462-4200. There is no charge for this service.
