BRUSH COLLECTION: Curbside brush collection is currently underway in the Borough during the month of July. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Any brush left at the curb after July 31st may result in a violation notice. Encourage your neighbors and friends to take advantage of this July brush collection as the next curbside pickup will not take place until October.

WATER & SEWER EMERGENCIES: The Water & Sewer Dept. has personnel available 7 days per week, 24 hours a day to respond to water/sewer emergencies. It is important to call the Borough before contacting a plumber in order to determine who is responsible to make any necessary repairs. During regular business hours, call 732 462-4200 for assistance. After regular business hours, please call the Police Department at 732 462-1234 for assistance.

DISPOSAL OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES: Electronic devices such as computers, monitors, and television sets must now be recycled. A dumpster dedicated for these items is located at the Borough yard at 161 Center St. The yard is open during regular business hours, and from 7 a.m. to noon on the first Saturday of each month.

FREE RABIES CLINIC: The Board of Health will sponsor a free rabies clinic for all New Jersey residents on September 10, 2015 from 6-7 p.m. behind the fire house located at 49 West Main Street. Cats must be in carriers, and dogs must be leashed. For more information, please call 732 462 7057.
