



VACANT AND ABANDONED PROPERTIES: Freehold Borough recently adopted the Abandoned Property Rehabilitation Act which requires that all vacant and abandoned properties must be registered with the Borough in order to protect the health, safety, and general welfare of all Borough residents. Owners of vacant and abandoned properties should contact the Code Enforcement office at 732 462-4903 for registration forms and additional information.

BRUSH COLLECTION: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the month of July. Branches should be no more than 4 ft. in length.

INDEPENDENCE DAY: On the morning of July 4th, Borough residents will once again gather on the steps of Borough Hall at 9:00 a.m. for the annual reading of the Declaration of Independence. The fire bell will then be struck 50 times to commemorate each state, the flag will be raised, and we will recite the Pledge of Allegiance. The program will conclude with a stirring rendition of the Battle Hymn of the Republic. Any resident who would like to read a portion of the Declaration is invited to join us at 8:30 a.m., and we will provide you with a copy of the Declaration.

OLDE FREEHOLD DAY: Once again, the popular Olde Freehold Day will return to Lake Topanemus on Saturday, June 27th from noon - 6:00 pm (raindate Sunday, June 28th). The day will feature boating on the lake, children's rides, contests, games and crafts, live music, treasure hunts and refreshments. Admission is free.
