CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough throughout the month of October. Limbs should be cut into lengths of 4 ft. or less and placed at the curb for collection. Residents also have the option of bringing their branches to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month between the hours of 7:00 a.m. – noon.

HYDRANT FLUSHING: Fall flushing of fire hydrants will be conducted on Wednesday, October 14th, starting at 8:00 a.m. and continuing until all flushing has been completed. Residents may notice lower water pressure and a slight discoloration of the water as the flushing is performed in your area. The discoloration is not harmful and will clear up if you allow the water to run for a few extra minutes. Flushing is performed twice a year in order to remove any sediment that may accumulate in low flow areas of the water distribution system. The operation maintains the overall excellent water quality in our distribution system and ensures that each fire hydrant operates properly.

DISPOSAL OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES: Electronic devices such as computers, monitors, and television sets must now be recycled. A dumpster dedicated for these items is located at the Borough yard at 161 Center Street. It is the resident's or business owner's responsibility to transport these items to the collection site.

SENIOR CITIZEN'S APPRECIATION DAY: Freehold Borough's Human Relations Committee will host the annual Senior Citizens' Appreciation Day on Sunday, September 20th from noon to 5:00 p.m. at the Hall of Records Parking Lot located at One East Main Street.
