LEAF COLLECTION 2015: Leaf collection is currently underway throughout the Borough, and will continue until all leaves have been collected. Leaves may be left loose at the curb, or you may place them in open, clear plastic bags.

PARKING PERMITS: All Borough parking permits will expire on December 31st. The fee for a commuter permit is \$180.00 for Borough residents, and \$300.00 for non-residents. Business permits are \$96.00 per year, and a daily parking permit is \$5.00 per day. Renewal forms are available at Borough Hall and online at www.freeholdboro.org. PET LICENSE RENEWALS: Renewal applications for 2015 pet licenses are now available. Proof of rabies vaccination valid through October 31, 2015 must be provided in order to obtain a license. The fee for neutered dogs is \$11.20; for dogs who have not been neutered, the fee is \$14.20. The fee for a cat license is \$10.00. Late charges will be applied after February 28, 2015.

DISPOSAL OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES: Electronic devices such as computers, monitors, printers, and television sets must now be recycled. A dumpster dedicated for these items is located at the Public Works yard located at 161 Center Street. The yard is open during regular business hours, and also from 7:00 a.m. - noon on the first Saturday of each month.

WINTER REMINDERS: When streets are snow covered, vehicles may not be parked on any major road in the Borough until the snow has stopped falling, and the streets have been plowed to the extent that parking will not interfere with the regular flow of traffic. Please make every effort to remove your vehicles from the street in order to allow snowplows to clear the roadways. For residential property sidewalks, a pathway at least 4 ft. wide shall be cleared of ice and snow within 24 hrs. after the cessation of snowfall/and or ice formation. For non-residential properties, a pathway at least 6 ft. wide shall be cleared of snow and ice within 12 hrs. after the cessation of the snowfall and/or ice formation.

DISCARDED CHRISTMAS TREES: Discarded Christmas trees should be placed at the curb for collection during the month of January.
