**CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION 2016:** Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the months of March, July and October in 2016. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Residents also have the option of taking their brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month, from 7:00 a.m. to noon.

**HOUSING REHABILITATION:** Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. The program will provide repairs to major systems such as roofing, heating, electric, foundation repairs, and window replacement. **WINTER REMINDERS:** Please make every effort to remove your vehicles from the road in order to give the snow plows ample opportunity to clear away as much snow as possible. Do not deposit any ice and snow in the roadway. Residential property owners are reminded that snow must be cleared from the sidewalk within 24 hours after the snow stops falling. For non-residential properties, a pathway at least 6 ft. wide must be cleared of ice and snow within 12 hours after the snow has stopped falling.
