SPRING CLEANUP: There will be a Spring cleanup program conducted throughout the Borough during the month of April. Residents may place their limbs and brush at the curb for collection. Brush and limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length.

Curbside leaf collection will also take place during April. Leaves may be left loose at the curb, or they may be placed at the curb in clear, open plastic bags. Please note that brush and leaves must be in separate piles in order to prevent damaging the Borough equipment.

MURRAY STREET REPAVING: Earle Asphalt Co. will begin repaving Murray Street at the end of March or early in April. While the repaving work is underway, you will have limited, if any, access to Murray Street. Please plan your activities accordingly.

SPRING HYDRANT FLUSHING: Spring flushing of fire hydrants will be conducted on Wednesday, April 20th, starting at 8:00 a.m. and continuing until all flushing has been completed. Residents may notice a slight discoloration of the water as the flushing is conducted in their area. The discoloration is not harmful and will clear up if you allow the water to run for a few extra minutes. The flushing is performed twice a year in order to remove any sediment that may accumulate in the low flow areas of the water system. This flushing operation maintains the overall excellent water quality in our distribution system and ensures that each fire hydrant operates properly.

HOUSING REHABILITATION: Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. The program will provide repairs to major systems such as roofing, heating, electric, foundation repairs, and window replacement.
