**LEAF COLLECTION** is currently underway in the Borough, and will continue until all leaves have been collected. Leaves may be raked into neat piles at the curb, or they may be placed in clear, open plastic bags. Please be sure leaves do not interfere with any storm drains in your area.

**BRUSH DISPOSAL:** The Public Works yard located at 161 Center Street will be open every Saturday during the months of November and December for the collection of brush and recyclable items. The site will be open from 7:00 a.m. to noon. Please note that leaves are not included in this collection.

**SNOW ACCUMULATION AROUND FIRE HYDRANTS:** A newly adopted law requires the owner of a property which abuts a fire hydrant to remove any snow which may accumulate within 24 hours of the snow coverage. Failure to remove the snow may result in a bill for snow removal service in an amount not to exceed \$75.00.

**HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM:** The Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. Please call 609 664 2769 for more information.

**DISPOSAL OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES:** Electronic devices such as computers, monitors, printers, and television sets must now be recycled. A dumpster dedicated for these items is located at the Borough yard at 161 Center St. It is the resident's or business owner's responsibility to transport these items to the collection site.
