The fire bell will then be struck 50 times to commemorate each state, the flag will be raised, and we will recite the Pledge of Allegiance. If you would like to read a portion of the Declaration, please join us at 8:30 a.m., and we will provide you with a copy of the document.

POOL FILLS: Any resident wishing to fill a swimming pool should schedule a water meter reading before and after filling the pool. In that way, a credit can be issued on their next water bill for the water which did not enter into the sewer system.
