INDEPENDENCE DAY: On the morning of July 4th, Borough residents will once again gather on the steps of Borough Hall at 9:00 a.m. for the annual reading of the Declaration of Independence. The fire bell will then be struck 50 times to commemorate each state, the flag will be raised, and we will recite the Pledge of Allegiance. The program will conclude with a stirring rendition of the Battle Hymn of the Republic. Any resident who would like to read a portion of the Declaration is invited to join us at 8:30 a.m., and we will provide you with a copy of the Declaration.

BRUSH COLLECTION: The Spring leaf and brush collection have ended in the Borough. Residents may take their brush to the DPW yard located at 161 Center Street on the first Saturday of each month between the hours of 7:00 a.m.- noon. The next curbside pickup will take place during the month of July.

MEMORIAL DAY PARADE: Mark your calendars to view the Memorial Day Parade at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, May 29th. The parade is the oldest and largest such parade in Western Monmouth County. The parade will step off at 10:00 a.m. at the corner of West Main St. and Brinckerhoff Avenue.

LIBRARY NEWS: The library will now be open from 9 a.m. – 9 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Tuesday and Friday hours are 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., and Saturdays from 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. Worm and faded American flags may be dropped off at the library during the summer months for proper disposal late in August.

POOL FILLS: Any resident wishing to fill a swimming pool should schedule a water meter reading before and after filling the pool. In that way, a credit can be issued on the next water bill for the water which did not enter into the sewer system.
