**WATER METER UPGRADES:** Saks Metering is currently conducting a mandatory water meter replacement program in the Borough. If you have not already updated your water meter, please contact Saks Metering immediately at 732 730-5633 to schedule your appointment. Freehold Borough will not be able to provide you with water service in the future unless the meter has been updated.

**PET LICENSE RENEWALS:** Renewal applications for pet licenses will be mailed out in January. Proof of rabies vaccination through October 31, 2017 must be provided in order to obtain a license. The fee for neutered dogs is \$11.20; for non-neutered dogs, the fee is \$14.20. The fee for a cat license is \$10.00. Late charges will be applied after February 28, 2017.

**FREE RABIES CLINIC:** The Board of Health will sponsor a free rabies clinic on Saturday, February 25<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 – 11:00 a.m. at the Fire House located at 49 West Main St. The vaccinations are free. The clinic is open to all New Jersey residents. Dogs must be leashed, and cats must be in carriers. Please call the Board of Health at 732 294-2060 for more information.

**HOME REPAIR ASSISTANCE:** The Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low & moderate income persons. Please call 609 371-1937 for more information.

**WINTER REMINDERS - SNOW ACCUMULATION AROUND FIRE HYDRANTS:** A newly adopted law requires the owner of a property which abuts a fire hydrant to remove any snow which may accumulate within 24 hours of the snow coverage. Failure to remove the snow may result in a bill for snow removal service in an amount not to exceed \$75.00. Please note that the owner or tenant of a property bordering a sidewalk is responsible for the removal of all ice and snow within twelve (12) hours after it has accumulated.
