IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR VOTERS IN DISTRICT NO. 6: The polling place for voters in District 6 has been moved from the Freehold Learning Center to the Freehold Elks Lodge #1454, located at 73 East Main Street. Please contact the Borough Clerk's office at 732 462-1259 if you have any questions.

FALL HYDRANT FLUSHING: Fall flushing of fire hydrants will be conducted on Tuesday, October 17th, starting at 8:00 a.m. and continuing until all flushing has been completed. Residents may notice lower water pressure and a slight discoloration of water as the flushing is performed in your area. The discoloration is not harmful and will clear up if you allow the water to run for a few extra minutes.

BRUSH COLLECTION: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the month of October. Limbs must be cut in lengths of 4 ft. or less. Please do not place any brush at the curb before October 1. Residents also have the option of bringing their brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month between the hours of 7:00 a.m. – noon.

FREE PAPER SHREDDING EVENT: Borough residents are invited to safely dispose of up to 100 lbs. of their unwanted papers and documents at a free paper shredding event to be held on Saturday, September 30th, from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. at Borough Hall. It is not necessary to remove any staples, paper clips, or rubber bands from your documents.

HOUSING REHABILITATION: Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. The program will provide repairs to major systems such as roofing, heating, electric, foundation repairs, and window replacement. Please call for 609 664-2781 for more information.
