
## Book Group

**Roald Dahl** was born 1916 in Cardiff, Wales. Having lost his father at age three, he was raised by his mother and educated in British schools. He continued his education at Repton School in Derbyshire, where



one of his most important works, *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, would be conceived. Cadbury regularly sent chocolate bars to the school to be tested by the students; this led to Roald having dreams of creating a chocolate bar so delicious that Mr. Cadbury would praise it.

Dahl went on to be a Fighter Ace during WWII, and had a long and distinguished career in which he fought in some of the most significant air battles of the war. He served as a diplomat, writer, and intelligence officer. It was during this time that he wrote *The Gremlins*, his first children's book, for Walt Disney Productions, to promote a full-length film that remained unmade. During the course of his life he wrote 34 books, 5 screenplays, and 7 collections/anthologies.
