Private Thomas T. Fallon

- emigrated to Freehold from Ireland in 1859
- served in the Union Army during Civil War
- was awarded the Medal of Honor
- died in 1916; buried in Freehold (St. Rose of Lima Cemetery).

Glenn Cashion, Fallon's great nephew, will lead us on the trail to find the missing Medal, and share what it took to finally bring it back home to Freehold.
