

SNOW STORM ALERT

Please take a moment to review the following reminders in view of the anticipated snowstorm tomorrow:

- **RESIDENTS ARE REMINDED TO BE SURE TO REMOVE ALL BRUSH AND DEBRIS FROM THE CURB IN ORDER TO ALLOW THE SNOWPLOWS TO CLEAR THE STREETS.**
- **Please make every effort to remove your vehicles from the road in order to give the snow plows ample opportunity to clear away as much snow as possible..**
- **Do not deposit any ice and snow in the roadway.**
- Residential property owners are reminded that snow must be cleared from their sidewalk within 24 hours after the snow stops falling.
- For non-residential properties, a pathway at least 6 ft. wide shall be cleared of ice and snow within 12 hours after the snow has stopped falling.
- Do not use gas stoves, kerosene heaters, or other open-flame heat sources to prevent deadly carbon monoxide gas from building up in your home.
- Have a supply of bottled water and nonperishable food on hand, as well as any prescriptions and medications you may need. Also include a cell phone, flashlights, a portable radio, extra batteries, blankets and a first aid kit in with your emergency supplies.
- Electronic devices such as cell phones, laptops, and tablet computers should be kept fully charged in case of any emergency.
- Remember to provide food and water for your pets.
- Check in on elderly family members and neighbors.
- If it is necessary to leave your home during a snowstorm, be sure a family member or friend knows how to contact you in an emergency.
