**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 10 (VEHICLES
AND TRAFFIC), SECTION 10.12 (PARKING GENERALLY) OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEHOLD
PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF UNREGISTERED VEHICLES**

BE IT ORDAINED that Chapter 10.12 (Parking Generally) be amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1

Chapter 10.12 Parking Generally shall be amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 10.12.160 Prohibition of unregistered vehicles in parking yards and parking places.

- A.** Unless authorized by a sworn law enforcement officer, no person shall operate, park, leave, allow or be in possession of a motor vehicle which is unregistered or has a suspended registration in any parking yard, lot, parking place or location, which is open to the public or to which the public is invited, whether owned or maintained by a governmental entity or in conjunction with any business or enterprise, whether public, quasi-public or private.
- B.** Exemptions. This article shall not apply to:
 - 1. Private property to which the public is not invited, such as residential lots.
 - 2. Motor vehicles which are exempted from registration under Title 39 of the New Jersey Statutes, such as dealer inventory.
- C.** Removal. Any police officer is authorized to order the removal of any unregistered vehicle in violation of this article to a storage space or garage, and the expense involved in such a removal and storage of the vehicle shall be borne by the owner of the vehicle, except that the expense shall be borne by the lessee of a leased vehicle.

D. Violation-Penalty. The violation of this article shall subject the person so convicted, or pleading guilty, to a fine of \$100 for an unregistered vehicle and \$175 for a vehicle which has a suspended registration.

SECTION 2

If any part of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3

Any Ordinance or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and superseded.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with Law.
