ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEHOLD,
IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY
AMENDING CHAPTER 10 (TRAFFIC),
SCHEDULE 2 (NO PARKING) OF THE
REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE
BOROUGH OF FREEHOLD,
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH
AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Freehold, have reviewed the present Ordinance prohibiting parking on certain streets in the Borough of Freehold and believe there is an error regarding parking on Morris Street; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that it is in the public interest to revise said ordinance to protect the health and safety of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEHOLD, that Chapter 10 (traffic), Schedule 2 (no parking) of the revised general ordinances of the Borough of Freehold is hereby revised and supplemented by the addition of the following:

Section I

Section 10-3.3, Schedule II

No person shall park a vehicle at any time on the following section of street:

<u>Name</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Morris Street	East	From Schanck Street to Lafayette Place

Section II

All ordinances or provisions thereof which are inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III

Should any article or provision of this ordinance be deemed invalid or unconstitutional such ruling shall not effect the validity of the remaining terms of this ordinance.

Section IV

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.
