Service Information

The Concealed Carry Permits service allows for online submission of both initial and renewal applications. Approved applications are due for renewal every two (2) years. Renewal applications can be submitted up to four (4) months before the expiration date. Concealed Carry Permit applicants need to have been fingerprinted for firearms purposes in New Jersey and assigned an SBI number before they can apply for a Concealed Carry Permit. If you have never been fingerprinted for firearms purposes in New Jersey before, start with an application for an Initial Firearms I.D. card [here](#).

If you have lived outside of the state of New Jersey in the last ten (10) years, please fill out form SP-066 (Consent for Mental Health Records) and upload it to your application.

What will I need for submitting an Initial Concealed Carry Permit application? ▼

- SBI Number
- Upload of recent photograph (on a light background including head and shoulders)
- One (1) training record completed within the past two (2) years, instructor name, and qualification date
- Personal Information: including Social Security Number and Driver's License Number
- Background Information
- For Armored Car Applicants: Uploaded Employment Letter
- Contact Information for four (4) non-family related references
- Information on handguns to be carried
- \$200 Application Fee

What will I need for submitting a renewal Concealed Carry Permit application? ▼

- SBI Number, Last Name and Date of Birth for validation
- One (1) training record completed within past two (2) years, instructor name, and qualification date
- Any updates to Personal Information
- Upload of recent photograph (on a light background including head and shoulders)
- Background Information
- Any updates to Handgun Information
- \$200 Application Fee

Instructions for renewal

Photograph: Passport style photograph 2" by 2", light colored background. No hats and sunglasses.
Note: Do not use photo from your driver's license or passport, as picture will not be accepted.
(APPLICANT WILL BE REQUIRED TO UPLOAD PHOTO TO APPLICATION)

References: Names, addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses of four (4) non-family references that have known the applicant for at least three (3) years prior to submitting the application. References cannot be related to applicant by blood or law. References **will be** contacted by an investigator.

Fees Explained: Credit or Debit Card- At the end of the application, applicants will be required to pay the following fees to the State of New Jersey.

1. Concealed Carry Permit Application State fee \$50.00, plus online service fee \$5.00. Total Fee: \$55.00
2. 212A background check fee \$18.00, plus online service fee \$3.00. Total Fee: \$21.00
3. Total fee of \$76.00 (1&2) will be charged to credit/debit card entered by applicant.

Additional fee: In addition to the above fees, a fee of \$150.00 required by NJ State Law payable to the Freehold Borough Police Department must be made before your application is processed. The \$150.00 (check or money order) application fee can be paid at police records or mailed to the below address.
